Subject: DOC Population Breakout: 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter 2013, September 30, 2013

The following information is based on the DOC Institution Population on September 30, 2013. This report is divided into four sections.

Section 1 gives a general overview of the DOC institution population on September 30, 2013. The first table describes the DOC institution population using the offender level and sentence type versus the institution. Institutions are separated into three types, Prison, Community Corrections and Other which includes the Delaware Psychiatric Center and Compact Cases. The second table provides a historical look by quarter of the DOC institution population by offender type and status. Consistently, the prison population hovers around 50% of the total institutional population, jail between 7 and 8%, lifers between 7 and 8%, and detention ranging from 19% to 24%. Between 11 and 13% are Level IV and less than 0.5% are Level III. The remaining 1.5% of the Level V DOC institution population is mostly indefinite sentence offenders and less than 0.3% of the population is inmates sentenced to death. The third table in Section 1 illustrates the change in the institution population from June 30, 2013 to September 30, 2013. An overall increase of 55 offenders has occurred in the population between June 30<sup>th</sup> and September 30<sup>th</sup>, with an increase in Prisons of 125 offenders, a decrease of 69 offenders in Community Corrections, and a decrease of 1 offender in Other facilities. This increase follows a 96 person increase from 1<sup>st</sup> quarter 2013 to 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter 2013. The population has consistently increased since 4<sup>th</sup> quarter 2012.

Section 2 describes the demographic make-up of the DOC institution population on September 30, 2013. About 56.1% of the institution population is Black while 43.7% are White, and the remaining 0.02% is Other/Unknown. Just over 91% of the population is Male, and 8.5% is Female. In addition, almost 57% of the population is under the age of 35, with 77.7% of the population under the age of 45. This is a 11% difference from 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter 2013 where 68% of the population was under 35.

Section 3 portrays the length of stay for both the detention and sentenced populations in a DOC institution on September 30, 2013. Seventy-six percent of the detention population has been detained for 120 days or less, with only 1.6% detained more than 1 year. More than 50% of the sentenced population has served 1.5 years or less with 8% of the population serving 10 years or more. The final table describes the expected release for sentenced offenders with 54.3% of the September 30, 2013 sentenced population expected to be released in the next two years.
