Subject: DOC Population Breakout: 3rd Quarter 2011, September 30, 2011

The following information is based on the DOC Institution Population on September 30, 2011. This report is divided into four sections.

Section 1 gives a general overview of the DOC institution population on September 30, 2011. The first table describes the DOC institution population using the offender level and sentence type versus the institution. Institutions are separated into three types, Prison, Community Corrections and Other which includes the Delaware Psychiatric Center and Compact Cases. The second table in Section 1 illustrates the change in the institution population from June 30, 2011 to September 30, 2011. An overall increase of 95 offenders has occurred between the population on June 30th and September 30th, with an increase in Prisons of 67 offenders, Community Corrections at 21 offenders, and Other institutions of 7 offenders.

Section 2 describes the demographic make-up of the DOC institution population on September 30, 2011. Almost 58.3% of the institution population is Black while 41.5% are White, and the remaining 0.1% are Other. Ninety-two percent of the population is Male, and 8.2% is Female. In addition, more than half of the population is under the age of 30, with 87.5% of the population under the age of 45.

Section 3 portrays the length of stay for both the detention and sentenced populations in a DOC institution on September 30, 2011. Almost 80% of the detention population has been detained for less than 120 days, with only 1.3% detained more than 1 year. More than 50% of the sentenced population has served less than 2 years with 14.2% of the population serving 10 years or more. The final table describes the expected release for sentenced offenders with 56.8% of the September 30, 2011 sentenced population expected to be released in the next two years. The final table displays the Superior Court detention population by quarter since March 31, 2008. The total 2nd quarter 2011 Superior Court detention population has decreased overall by 9 individuals, with a 28 person decrease in active cases, and a 19 person increase in the non-sentenced detention category. The current Superior Court detention population for 2011 is following a similar pattern as 2nd Quarters 2008, 2009 and 2010.
