SUBJ: Felony C Sentencing Patterns 2004

Attached are analyses that summarize the 2004 Superior Court sentencing patterns for Felony C cases. A Felony C case includes a Superior Court conviction that contains at least one Felony C charge as part of the case. If there is more than one Felony C charge in a case, the most serious charge is used to define it. In 2004, there were a total of 431 Felony C convictions.

Of these, 386 of the Felony C convictions were sentences where both the SENTAC guidelines and Truth-in-Sentencing were applied. The presumptive SENTAC sentence for a Felony C conviction is Level V term up to 30 months. Truth in Sentencing requires that at least 75 percent of the Level V term actually be served. Credit for time served in detention prior to sentencing for charges of conviction is accounted for and recorded as Level V time.

There were also 45 "addiction" sentences. While an "addiction sentence" complies with the Felony C SENTAC Level V presumptive sentencing, it does not require the Truth in Sentencing 75 percent time served. These sentences allow for the suspension of the Level V sentence on successful completion of the Department of Correction's prison treatment or the boot camp program

Of the 431 Felony C convictions, 74.5 percent received at least some Level V time including credit for time served sentences.

³ These Assault 1st Crimes were pled from Attempted Murder 1st. The Assault 1st Statute changed June 29, 2003 from a Felony C to a Felony B.

⁴ These Unlawful Sexual Intercourse 3rd Crimes occurred before September 8, 1998 when this Statute was retired.

⁵ Burglary 1st has a two year mandatory as of July 2003 when House Bill 210 was enacted.

⁶ Possession With Intent To Deliver a Narcotic has a Minimum Mandatory for "Repeat Offenders" of 3 years except for Heroin which is 5 years as of July 2003 when House Bill 210 was enacted.

⁷ Level V Deferred refers to Sentences where the defendant was Sentenced to Level V with an effective date set later than the Sentence Date with a Review of Sentence scheduled before the effective date.

2004 Felony C Most Serious Offense Summary

- Statutory Range
 - According to DE Title 11 Section 4205 Felony C Sentences have the following Statutory Range:
 - Prior to June 2003- Up to 10 years at Level V
 - After June 2003 through the present- Up to 15 years at Level V
- Statutory Minimum Mandatory Sentences
 - According to the 2004-2005 Delaware Criminal and Traffic Law Manual there are only two Felony C Statutes with minimum mandatory sentences:
 - DE Title 11 Section 0826 Burglary in the first degree- Subsection (b)(1) A two year minimum mandatory sentence at Level V, or Subsection (b)(2) a four year minimum mandatory sentence if the crime occurs within five years of the date of a previous conviction for Burglary first or second degree or if the conviction is for an offense that was committed within five years of the date of termination of all periods of incarceration or confinement imposed pursuant to a previous conviction for Burglary first or second degree conviction. Any sentence imposed pursuant to subsection (b)(2) shall not be subject to the provisions of DE Title 11 Section 4205 of this title. Sentencing provisions apply to Attempted Burglary in the first degree as well as Burglary in the first degree.
 - DE Title 16 Section 4751 PWITD Narcotics- When referencing DE Title 16 Section 4763 (Repeat Drug Sales) PWITD Narcotics has a Minimum Mandatory of three years and a maximum of five years for Repeat Drug Sale Offenses except for Possession of Heroin, which has a minimum mandatory of five years and a maximum of 10 years for Repeat Drug Sale Offenses.
- SENTAC Presumptive Sentencing Guidelines
 - The Presumptive Sentence for a Violent Felony C is up to 30 Months at Level V (as of 6/2003, statutory maximum is now 15 years at Level V. Prior to 6/2003 the statutory maximum was 10 years at Level V).
 - The Presumptive Sentence for a Non Violent Felony C is up to One Year at Level V.
