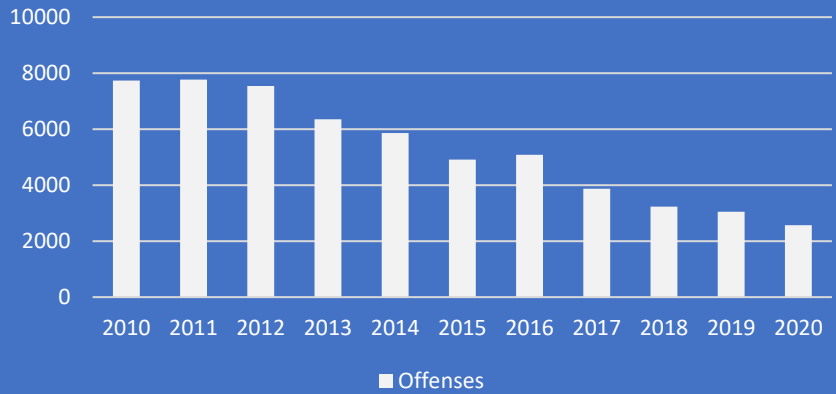
Burglary - 2020

The Federal Bureau of Investigation defines Burglary as:
"The unlawful entry into a building or other structure with the intent to commit a felony or a theft."

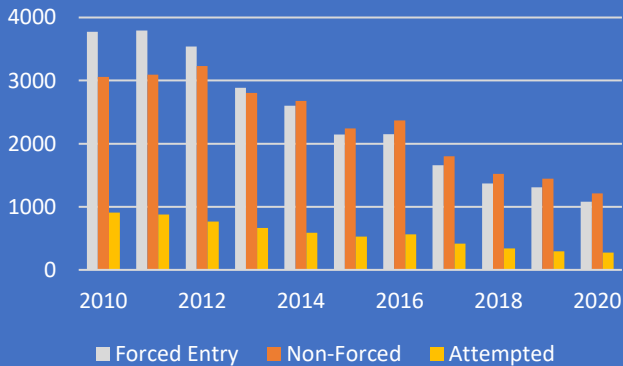
FACTS:

- Burglary offenses accounted for almost 4% of all Group A Offenses in 2020.
- 69% of 2020 Burglaries occurred at a home or residence.
- In 2020, Burglary offenses were associated with \$6.9 Million in property losses in total.

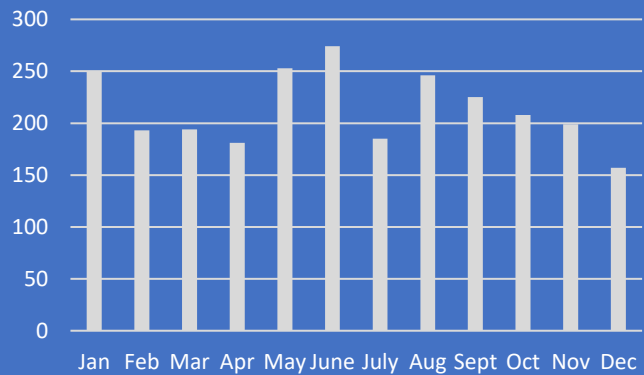
Burglary Offenses by Year
