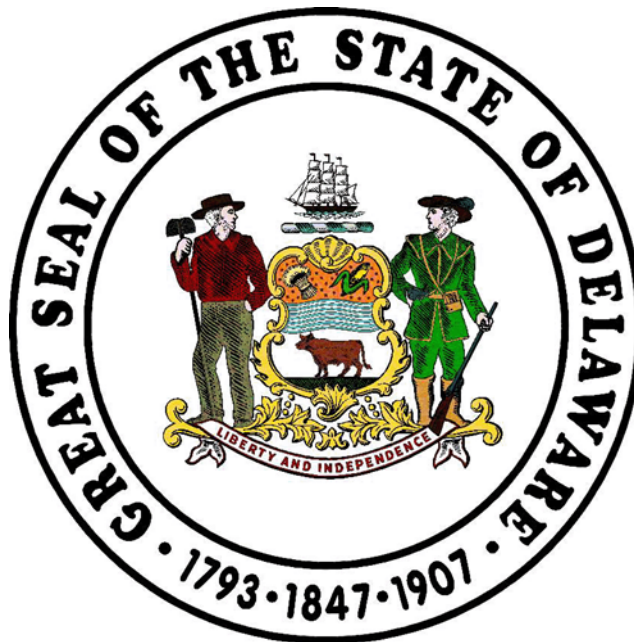

Wilmington Supplement

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Crime in Delaware 2021 – 2025 is the official report of serious crimes known to Delaware law enforcement from 2021 through 2025. The report provides extensive data about crime at the state and county levels. This supplement reflects an evolving effort within the *Crime in Delaware* reporting process to provide extensive crime data about the City of Wilmington.

The methods used to prepare and analyze Wilmington’s data are the same as those described in the main *Crime in Delaware* report, with one exception: data for Wilmington’s two law enforcement agencies—the Wilmington Police Department and the Wilmington Fire Marshal—were first merged before analyzing the city’s data.

In this supplement, tables and figures with summary level data about offenses, clearances, and arrests are presented first. These are followed by detailed data tables with counts of offenses and clearance percentages, and adult and juvenile arrests (Tables 3 – 14). Summaries of key findings from each level of data are also included and precede the two sections.

Cautionary Note: As discussed in the full report and Executive Briefing, caution should be used when comparing trends involving 2021 data and in interpreting the 2021 to 2025 differences. As national, regional, and international research has emerged, the

COVID-19 pandemic and subsequent State of Emergency declarations, court closings, and travel restrictions within the State of Delaware likely had differential impacts on crime and arrests. The Center’s exploration of these potential impacts on trends will be completed later in 2026.

Note: Use caution when interpreting data for the Fraud crimes of Identity Theft and Hacking/Computer Invasion. Issues with the way these crimes were coded in the downloaded data accounts for the drastic swing in the counts for these crimes. The SAC does not yet have a means for correcting these counts.

Wilmington Serious Crime At-a-Glance 2021 – 2025

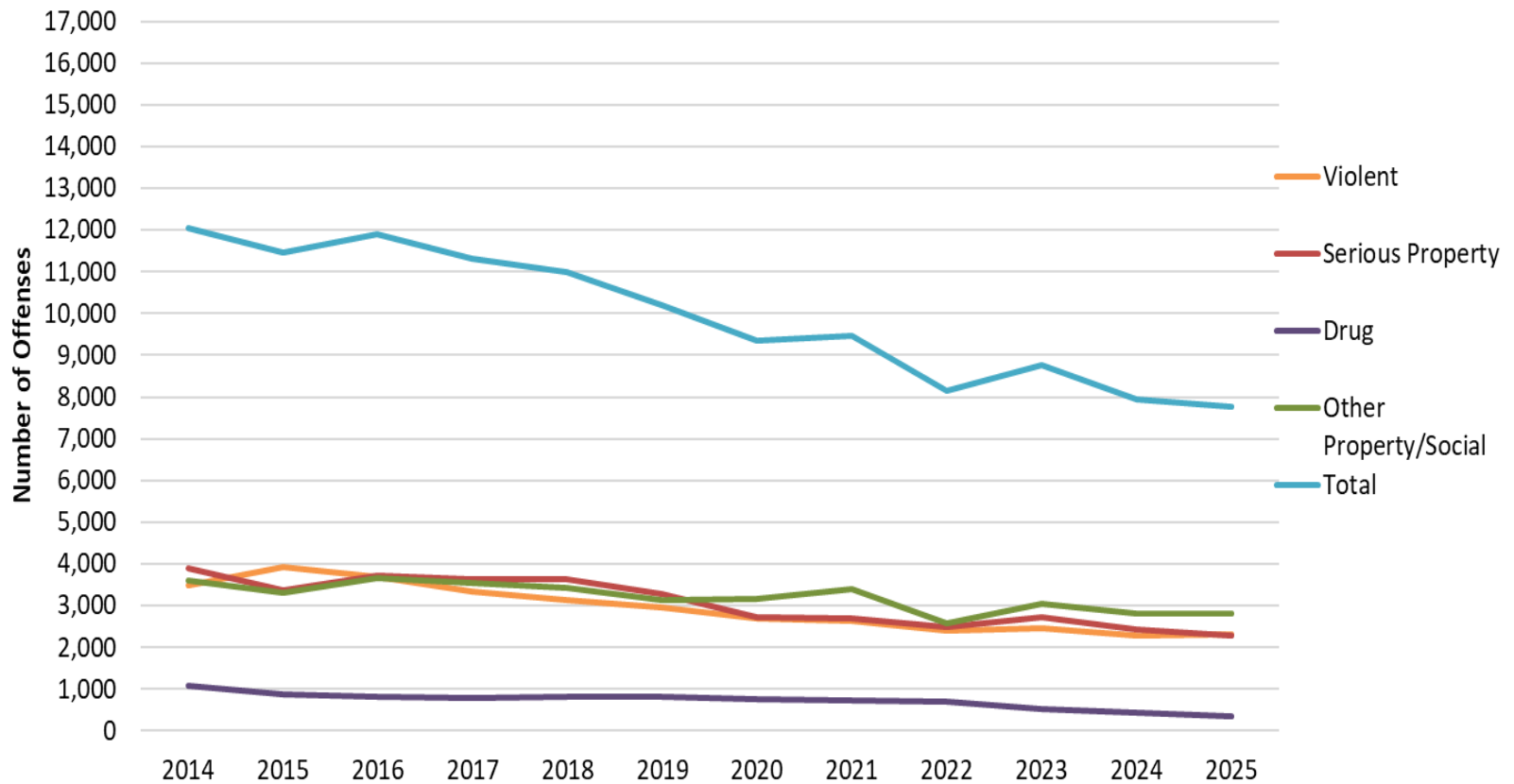


Figure 2: Serious Crime in Wilmington by Category, 2014 – 2025 (Categories Only)

Overall, 1,688 fewer Group A Offenses were reported in Wilmington in 2025 compared to 2021, a decline of 17.9%, continuing a long overall downward trend (see Table 1 and Figure 1). All major crime categories were lower in 2025 compared to 2021, with the greatest declines in Drug Offenses (53%) and Other Property and Social Offenses (17.1%). See Figure 1 for long-term trends since 2014. Long-term trends just for the four offense categories are presented in Figure 2 to allow for easier differentiation between those categories.

The most frequently reported offenses in the city were Assault; Property Destruction/Vandalism; Larceny/Theft; Motor Vehicle Theft; Drug/Narcotic; Weapon Law Violations, and Burglary (see Figure 3)¹. All seven offenses experienced declines when comparing 2021 to 2025. Drug/Narcotic Offenses and Weapon Law Violations saw the largest decreases (53% and 23.6%, respectively). Four of

¹ While Motor Vehicle Theft ranked in the top six most frequently occurring offenses in 2025, historically, its frequency has lagged behind that for Burglary. As a result, Motor Vehicle Theft is not included in Figure 9.

the remaining crimes experienced significant declines ranging from 11.7% to 21.8%). Motor Vehicle Theft increased slightly (3.1%) compared to 2021, but was 8.8% lower compared to 2024.

The number of homicides in 2025 was 42.5% lower compared to 2021 (which had the reporting-period high of 40) and 8% lower compared to 2024.

2025 offenses in all main crime categories were cleared at rates comparable to those from 2021 through 2024 (see Table 1 and Figure 4). Overall, 33.6% of all offenses committed in 2025 were cleared by the end of the calendar year, with 50% of Violent Offenses cleared and 81.6% of Drug Offenses cleared. Long-term clearance trends as recorded by the end of the calendar year can be seen in Figure 4.

The number of adult and juvenile arrests decreased from 2021 to 2025 (23.5% and 19.6%, respectively). Yearly arrest totals vary from year to year. Adult and juvenile arrest totals across all but one crime category (juvenile arrests for Violent Offenses) were substantially lower compared to 2021. Long-term trends in arrests can also be seen in Figure 4.

Drug Offense Changes: In 2015, Delaware decriminalized certain marijuana possession offenses. The federal government still records these offenses as criminal, so they remain in the Drug Offense totals in this report. An arrest may not be made for possession offenses deemed “civil offenses” by Delaware.

Serious Crime in Wilmington by Category, 2014-2025

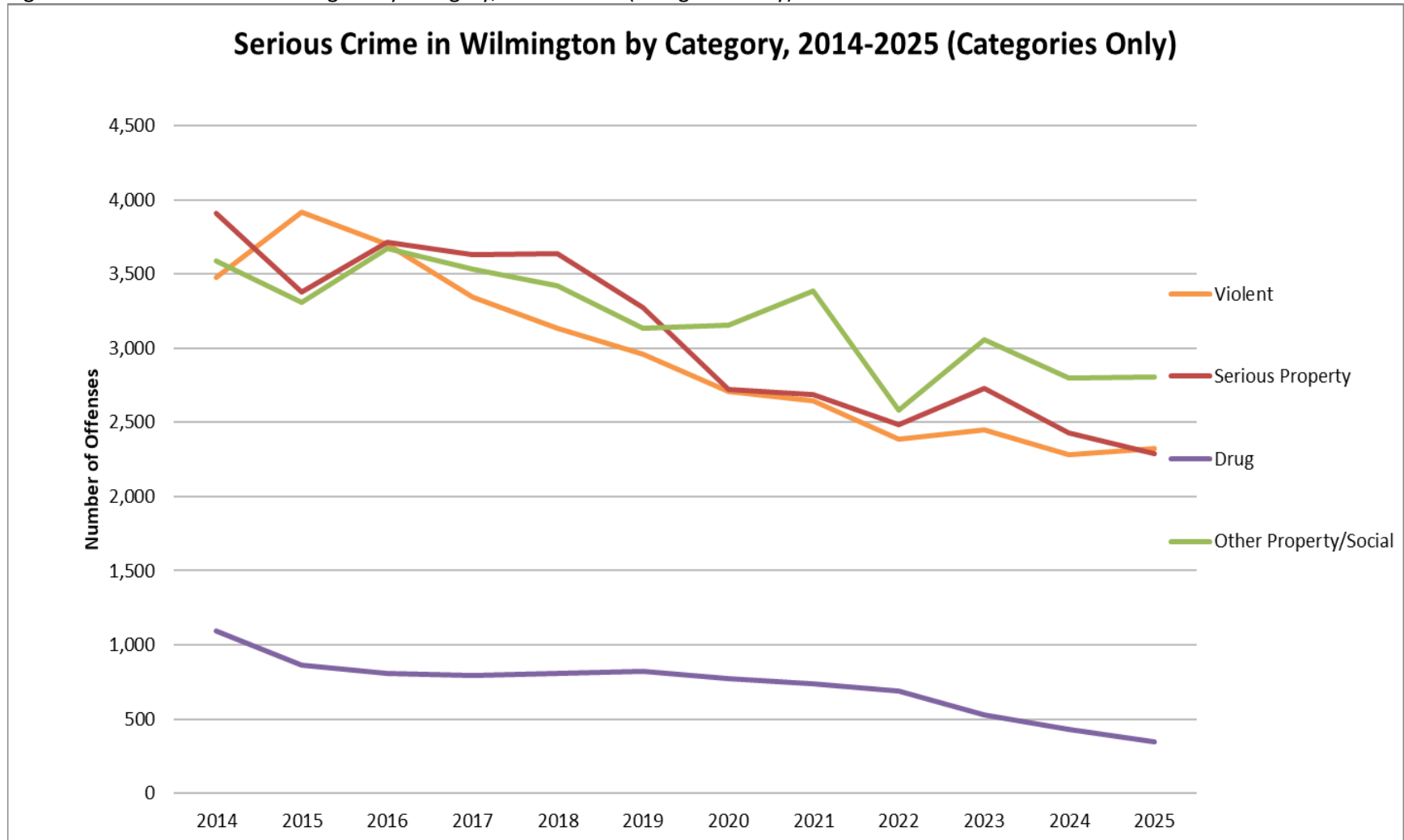

Figure 3: Most Common Serious Crimes in Wilmington, 2014 – 2025

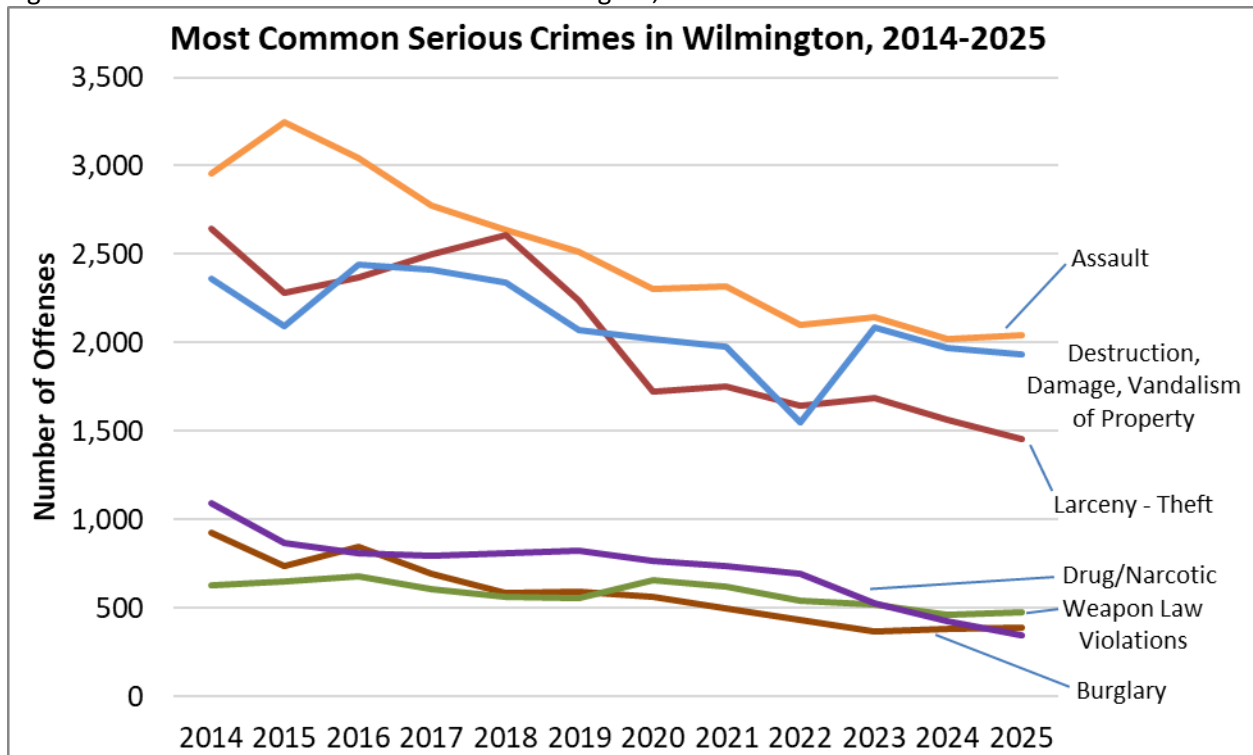
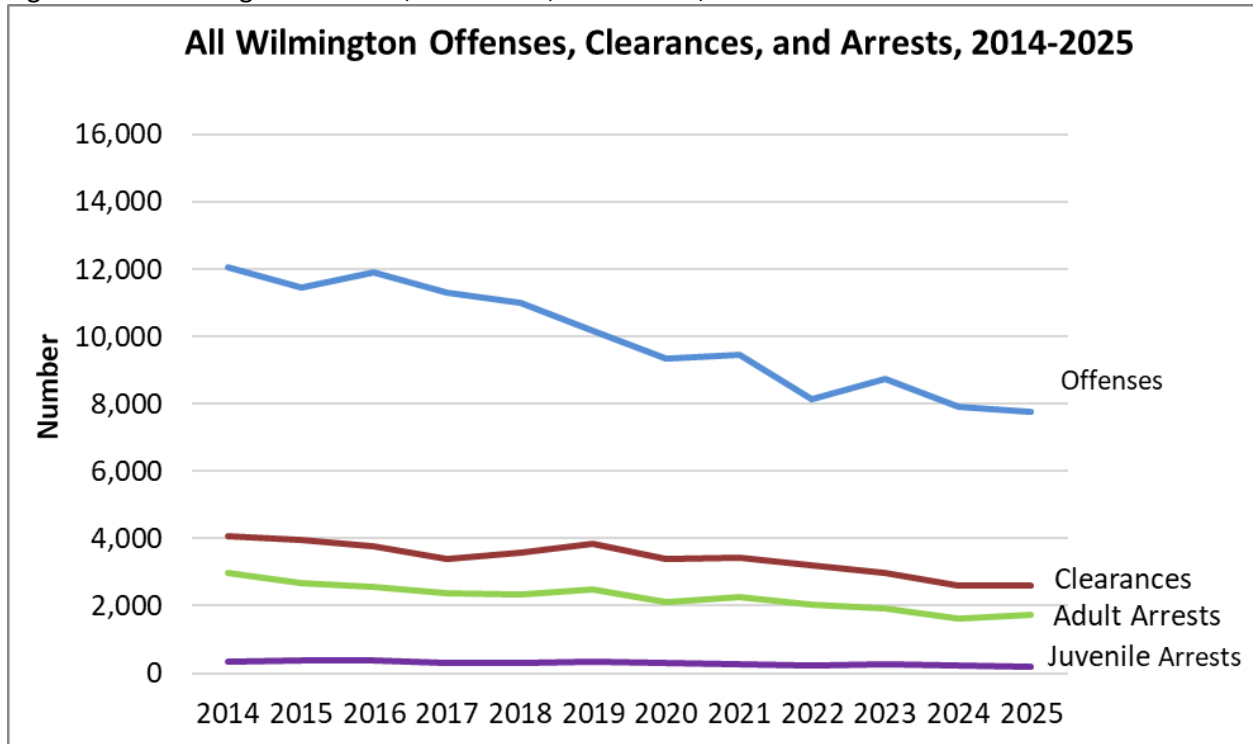


Figure 3: All Wilmington Offenses, Clearances, and Arrests, 2014 – 2025



A Detailed Look at Crime in Wilmington

The following section provides more detailed information about serious crime in Wilmington. Included is a summary of notable findings for specific crimes within the four crime categories (Violent Offenses, Serious Property Offenses, Drug/Narcotic Offenses, Other Property and Social Offenses). The 2021-2025 report continues the changes made in the previous version—tables that present offense, clearance, and arrest data reflect the approach taken in the *Crime in Delaware* report: offense counts and clearance percentages are presented together, and all data are grouped based on the four main crime categories. The data tables are presented on pages 11 – 24.

Violent Offenses

- The number of 2025 Criminal Homicides (23) was 42.5% lower than the record set in 2021 (40).
- Forcible Sex Offenses were 56.8% lower in 2025 as compared to 2021.
- Robbery and Assault offenses both decreased (7.1% and 11.7%, respectively) compared to 2021.
- Assault offenses that involved the use of a firearm were 34.7% lower compared to 2021; Robbery offenses involving a firearm were down 11.1%.

Note: In 2019 the FBI began including Vehicular Homicides under the Criminally Negligent Manslaughter category. Those offenses were not previously included in the NIBRS Homicide summary totals. This change has had minimal effect on Wilmington Homicide totals to date.

Serious Property Offenses

- Burglary offenses were 21.8% lower in 2025 compared to 2021.
- The number of all Larceny/Theft offenses in 2025 was 17.1% lower compared with 2021.
- Within that subcategory of crime:
 - Theft of Motor Vehicle Parts/Accessories declined 71.1% from 2021 to 2025.
 - The number of Theft from a Building offenses was 18.6% lower than 2021.
 - The number of Shoplifting offenses in 2025 decreased 32.4% from 2021, 34% compared to 2024.
 - The number of Theft from a Motor Vehicle offenses decreased 4.1% since 2021.
 - Motor Vehicle Theft offenses experienced a 3.1% increase compared to 2021, but an 8.8% decrease since 2024.

Drug/Narcotic Offenses

- Total Drug Offenses in Wilmington were down 53% overall from 2021 to 2025.
- Drug/Narcotic Possession offenses decreased 55.5%, and Drug Equipment offenses, 38.7%.

Other Property and Social Offenses

- The number of total Fraud offenses was down 57.7% from 2021 to 2025.
- Property Destruction/Vandalism offenses were slightly lower (2.4%) in 2025 compared to 2021.
- Weapon Law Violations were 23.6% lower compared to 2021.
